Isaiah 49:13-16(v. 15)

¹⁵ Can a woman forget her sucking child, that she should not have compassion on the son of her womb? **yea, they may forget, yet will I not forget thee.**

Teaching Purpose

Answers the question, "How should I understand this verse?" Is the passage dealing with a:

S	P	E	C	S
<u>Sin</u> to confess and forsake?	<u>Promise</u> to claim?	<u>Example</u> to follow?	<u>Command</u> to obey?	<u>Situation</u> or <u>State of mind</u> to avoid before it develops into a sin?

Sermonic Principle(s)

Answers the question, “What’s in it, or what’s the take away for me?”

- I) God Cares for HIS Kids!
- II) God always has the **“BEST INTEREST”** of His children in mind and heart!
- III) God is totally **committed** to the **well-being** of his children!
- IV) **R/ R/ NF**
GOD is **RELATIONAL. . .**
He is a **FATHER** and
HE has a **FAMILY!!**

v) The Question that **births** God's Promise
