Psalm 149:1-9 (v. 6-9)

6 Let the high praises of God be in their mouth, and a two-edged sword in their hand;

7 To execute vengeance upon the heathen, and punishments upon the people;

8 To bind their kings with chains, and their nobles with fetters of iron;

9 To execute upon them the judgment written: this honour have all his saints.
Praise ye the LORD.

PRAISE AND POWER PART #4

Teaching Purpose

Answers the question, “How should I understand this verse?” Is the passage dealing with a:

S	P	E	C	S
<u>Sin</u> to confess and forsake?	<u>Promise</u> to claim?	<u>Example</u> to follow?	<u>Command</u> to obey?	<u>Situation</u> or <u>State of mind</u> to avoid before it develops into a sin?

Sermonic Principle(s)

Answers the **Question**, “What’s in it, or What’s the take away for me?”

- 1) Psalm 149 was written by David, a shepherd / poet / musician / warrior and King

Sermonic Principle(s) - cont.

- 2) David was the servant of GOD that **experienced and expressed**
 - a) Praise and Power
 - b) Adoration and Adversity
 - c) Song and Sword
 - d) Worship and Warfare
- 3) **R / R / NF**....as with David so with every Child of GOD / Servant of GOD
- 4) Sometimes the Servant's **2-Edged Sword** is Literal and Deadly
- 5) Sometimes that 2-Edged Sword **MUST** be **Actively and Aggressively USED** against the enemy (enemies) of HIS KING and HIS PEOPLE

WTPT? HTPP?

- 6) The Child of GOD....
The SERVANT of GOD **MUST**....
Possess....The **SPIRIT of The SON** to express **WORSHIP** and
The **SPIRIT of The SOLDIER** to execute **WAR!**

7) **R/R/NF...** that “there is a **CAUSE...**
which we **MUST** fight **FOR**...and a **CAUSE**
which we **MUST** fight **AGAINST** !!!
