

# HUBER MEMORIAL CHURCH BOOK SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

## First time applicant

### Introduction

This application outlines the minimum requirements to establish eligibility for the Huber Memorial Book Scholarship Program. This book scholarship is intended to help with the cost of books as our students continue their education. Huber is blessed and honored to be able to offer this support to our high school seniors. In an effort to help our youth realize that they are Responsible, Accountable, and Privileged, we are tailoring these requirements to inspire and direct our youth on their responsibility to give back to our Huber family, and their accountability back to the family.

High school seniors must have attended the High School Senior's Bible Study class beginning in October and concluding in June. These classes run concurrently with the regular Bible Study classes. The classes are from 7pm to 8:30pm on Tuesday nights at Huber Memorial Church. (Those persons who are currently in college and have not received book scholarship support in the past must demonstrate their participation in a Bible study and how you have continued to give back to the church.)

### *MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS THAT MUST BE MET IN ORDER TO QUALIFY FOR A SCHOLARSHIP:*

- The student must have accepted Jesus Christ as their Lord and Savior.
- The student must be a member of Huber Memorial for at least 1 year.<sup>1</sup>
- The student must be a current High School Senior with a cumulative 2.5 GPA and plans to attend at least a 2-year college or technical school immediately following graduation. The student must submit a transcript of the high school grades.
- The student must be an active member of Huber Memorial's Youth Ministry. Active is defined as 1) attending and participating in regular Bible Study, 2) attending Sunday morning worship service regularly, 3) participating in the Youth ministry or some other Huber ministry on a regular basis, and 4) participating in the giving process through the church envelope system.
- After entering the college or technical school, the student must continue to fellowship and function as part of the ministry when in the geographic area.
- The student must submit a written pledge to make a financial contribution to the scholarship program after graduation.

*IF YOU MEET THE ABOVE MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS, WHAT IS NEXT?*

- Complete the scholarship application.
- Prepare a written pledge (and sign the pledge) that states your dedication to making a financial contribution to the Huber Memorial Scholarship Program after your graduation.
- Write a 250 word (minimum) essay describing yourself, your choice of study, career plans, how you will continue to fulfill your Christian responsibilities learned at Huber Memorial Church, and why you are a good candidate for the scholarship.
- Obtain a copy of your transcript containing current grades with current cumulative grade point average.

**Submit the COMPLETED application package (including: 1) the application, 2) written pledge, 3) essay, AND 4) current transcript of grades) to the Huber Memorial Church Office or to Dr. Lisa Brown by the due dates indicated below.**

**DUE DATES:**

**If applying for a SPRING semester book scholarship, the application is due on the last Friday in December.**

**If applying for a FALL semester book scholarship, the application is due on the last Friday in June.**

**PLEASE CHECK THE WEBSITE AND THE HUBER HERALD IN JUNE AND IN DECEMBER FOR SPECIFIC DUE DATES EACH SEMESTER.**

The Huber Memorial Scholarship Committee will review your application. A recommendation will be made to the Pastor. If awarded, you will receive an award letter detailing the requirements you must meet to maintain your eligibility to receive the book scholarship from Huber Memorial.
