Romans 12: 1-2

(1) I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service. (2) And be not con-formed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye prove what is that good and perfect, will of God.

Teaching Purpose

Answers the question, "How should I understand this verse?" Is the passage dealing with a:

Sermonic Principle(s)

Answers the question, "What's in it, or what's the take away for me?"

- 1) The New Testament Book of Romans is "The New Testament Book of Theology and Doctrine!
- 2) In this Book...Paul declares that "The Gospel" is the Divinely Appointed means of producing Righteousness in Man!
- 3) The Book of Romans can be divided into 3 parts:

Chapters 1-8: God's Righteousness and Salvation

Chapters 9-11: God's Righteousness and Israel

Chapters 12-16: God's Righteousness and Practical Christianity

- 4) No Christian lives his/her life ALONE!
- 5) There are NO freelance Christians!
- 6) We are ALIVE IN CHRIST...TOGETHER!

- 7) R / R / NF Chapter 11 verse 36 connects what has been said in Chapters 1-11 to what will be said in Chapters 12-16.
- 8) WTPT? HTPP!

In light of the Mercies of God ... (what God has done for US)!

- a) God met our desperate NEED to Get Right with HIM.
- b) God provided the POWER to be Set Free from the Bondage of Sin in this Life ... and He Gives US Eternal Life.
- c) God has given US the most Glorious Purpose In Life "Proclaiming the GOOD NEWS of GOD'S SON which is How to be set free from Sin and Death to Eternal Life."
- 9) In Light of these Mercies (what God has done for US), We are to Totally Devote Ourselves to God
 - a) for HIS GLORY and
 - b) for Our GOD

- 10) Paul "Beseeches" the Christians in Rome and the Christians in Baltimore to present their/our bodies to GOD as a Living Sacrifice.
- 11) The little-big word Beseech paints two (2) different pictures of Paul's Behavior
 - a) Beseech meaning Paul comes along side a fellow Christian and passionately calls out / pleads / appeals / and begs his brother / sister in the faith to do something on his own behalf!
 - b) Beseech meaning Paul comes before his Christian brothers and sisters as a military commander Exhorting his troops to fight

 Warning them of the realities of warfare

 Describing what they will face in the battle and

 Urging them to fight and keep on fighting bravely until Victory is Won!

12) WTPT? HTPP!

When You decide to be a Christian and dedicate your life to THE LORD ... Totally ... as a LIVING Sacrifice ... the Battle begins ... against You ... against the Carnal Nature in You so "Get Ready To Rumble"! Fight Until Victory Is Won!!
